I am writing to each of you in a sincere effort to get everyone who is a named "plaintiff" in the major case of Felter v. Kempthorne to pay up on your original amounts to join the case.

At this time, it extremely important for all of you to pay into our client fund. I am requesting that regardless of what you have paid or haven't paid that each of you send in \$200.00 now.
